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Dauntsey Guns Ltd commission sale policy T&Cs

1. Authority to Sell

By transferring your guns to Dauntsey Guns Ltd for a commission sale the client confirms that:

- They are the legal owner of the goods or have full authority to sell them.
- The goods are not stolen, subject to finance, or can be claimed by any third party.
- The goods are in good working order with no known issues.

2. Conditions & Fees

- Our commission is **25% of the final sale price, plus VAT at the prevailing rate.**
- All guns transferred to us for commission sale should be free of faults and fouling, as Dauntsey Guns will not be liable for any resultant degradation. Should the goods be found to be faulty we reserve the right to make an administration charge to identify any remedial work needed.
- The cost of any remedial work required to make the goods saleable will be advised to the client and the client will be given the choice of going ahead with the necessary work or given the option to scrap or collect the gun.
- Should the client decide to scrap the gun (see 6 for unsold goods policy), a scrappage administration fee of £20 will be made to cover the production of the necessary legal documentation for this.
- The cost of any remedial work required (if applicable) will be either deducted from the sale proceeds or charged in advance of sale.

3. Sale Price & Method

- We will use reasonable discretion to market and sell the goods at a fair price, and this will be agreed with the client and be shown on the commission sale agreement.
- A bottom-line figure will also agree and Dauntsey Guns will not accept a figure lower than this without gaining the owner's permission.
- We may contact the client at any time during the sale process to advise them that a sale price reduction may aid the sale. Any asking price or bottom-line figure changes will be agreed with the client (see 6 for applicable policy in the event the client is uncontactable).





4. Cooling off period

- Following the sale of a client owned gun, there will be a cooling off period of 4 weeks. This is to allow the purchaser to use the gun and decide if they are happy with the purchase. If the purchaser of the gun is not happy with the purchase they can return the item for a refund. In this event, the gun will be reassessed and the client informed of our findings and recommendations to achieve a successful sale.
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5. Payment to Client

- Payment of the net sale proceeds (sale price minus commission, VAT, and any agreed costs) will be paid to the client once the cooling off period has ended without any reported issues being raised by the purchaser.
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6. Unsold Goods

- If goods remain unsold, the client may collect their gun, subject to possession of current applicable certification. Alternatively, they will be advised to either scrap or store their gun (please refer to our storage policy for more details).
- We reserve the right to cease offering the goods for sale at any time if we believe the goods no longer reach our minimum sale value (currently £200).
- It is the customers responsibility to inform Dauntsey Guns of any changes to their notification methods. In the event that the client is uncontactable by phone, email and letter for a period of 60 days from written notification, we will deem the gun abandoned and take possession of the gun.

7. Collection of Items

- Items may only be collected by the owner or an authorised person, the details of the authorised person must be notified in writing, the authorised person will need to be currently legally certified to possess the guns in order to collect.
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By placing your guns on commission sale with Dauntsey Guns Ltd, you are agreeing to our terms and conditions as specified herein.
